Over 75,000 new housing units are projected to be built in the Highway 50 Corridor over the next twenty years. Major transportation projects will be required to ease current congestion and accommodate growth.

Public jurisdictions and private land owners have joined to form a private/public partnership called the Hwy 50 Corridor Mobility Partnership

to address the unique transportation funding issues the Hwy 50 Corridor faces. The Partnership is the first of its kind in the Sacramento region and is a model likely to be emulated elsewhere in the state.
